SIGHTSEEING

City tour with Schönbrunn (3hrs)

See this Imperial city's most significant sights – the State Opera House, Hofburg, Parliament, City Hall, Burgtheatre, the University and Votiv Church, the Giant Ferris Wheel in Prater, Belvedere Palace and Schönbrunn Palace.

Daily 9.45 & 14.00 hrs 1 Jan-31 Mar, 1 Nov-31 Dec.

Daily 9.45, 10.45 & 14.45 hrs 1 Apr-31 Oct.

Following Sisi's footsteps (3hrs)

Stroll through the old city and visit the Imperial Crypt, burial place of the Habsburgs. You then have a chance to watch the famous Lipizzaner horses train. Your sightseeing finishes with a guided tour of Hofburg, the official residence of Empress Elizabeth (Sisi) and Emperor Franz Joseph.

Entrance fee for Spanish Riding School to be paid on the spot.

Vienna Woods-Mayerling (4hrs)

This half-day excursion visits the beautiful southern Vienna Woods, the romantic valley of Helenental and the former Mayerling hunting lodge. Continue to the Cistercian Abbey of Heiligenkreuz, dating from 1133, then on to the Seegrotte for a boat ride on Europe's largest underground lake. The tour concludes at the Opera House.

Vienna Wine Tavern Serenade (3.5hrs)

Take a ride on the Giant Ferris Wheel at the Prater with marvelous view over the city. Your night continues in Neustift am Walde where, while enjoying your dinner at the wine tavern, the artists of the Viennese Heurigen show will entertain you with a selection of famous waltz melodies, polkas and romantic arias.

Wachau – Danube Valley (8hrs)

Full day tour filled with history and legend, and a boat ride to Wachau. See old villages and steep vineyards and pass Dürnstein Castle where Richard the Lionheart was imprisoned. Visit Melk with its magnificent Benedictine Abbey before returning to Vienna.

Salzburg (13hrs)

Drive through the beautiful Salzkammergut landscape of mountains and lakes, where the Emperor Franz Joseph and his family used to spend their holidays. You reach Salzburg in time for a lunch break and have an afternoon stroll through the old city. You will visit Mozart's birthplace in the Getreidegasse and the gardens of the Mirabell Palace.

Budapest (13hrs)
