Cruising through the islands off the Dalmatian coast on Old-timer motorsailers offers a unique opportunity to experience the crystal clear waters and explore these unspoilt islands. Originally used by fishermen and traders, the Old-timer motorsailers are now purpose-built for tourists. The atmosphere on these wooden motor-boats is informal, with vessels accommodating 16-34 passengers and a crew of 6, including the captain and a cook. Travellers of different age groups from all over the world can relax, enjoying free time to swim and explore this unique region.



SHIP DESCRIPTIONS & FACILITIES

The ships vary in design, size and age. They feature a dining area and small sun deck. Cabins are compact but well maintained. On Deck cabins are located on or above the main deck and Under Deck cabins are below the main deck.

*We offer two categories of ships – **Category A+** and **Category A**.*

Category A+ ships are only available on Cruise **KL2 – from Split**. They are more spacious, and cabins are partially air-conditioned with private facilities and a towel is provided twice a week. They also include a complimentary walking tour of Dubrovnik and a Captain's Dinner.

Category A ships feature all cabins with private facilities, with a towel provided twice a week and are available on all cruise itineraries.

Category B ships, without private facilities, are available on request, but are generally utilized for young budget tour groups.
