## Sightseeing, concerts & trains

### SIGHTSEEING

#### Panoramic City Tour (3.5hrs)

Drive through Moscow's wide boulevards and historic districts. Highlights include Red Square, Cathedral of Christ the Saviour, the White House, Bolshoi Theatre and a panoramic view of Moscow from Sparrows' Hills. **Daily.**

#### City Tour with Moscow Metro (5hrs)

See Moscow's highlights – Red Square and the Kremlin walls, Cathedral of Christ the Saviour, Bolshoi Theatre and more. Travel underground for an amazing display of marble, mosaics, chandeliers and sculptures. Each station is unique. Established in 1935, the Moscow Metro is one of the most efficient transport systems in the world. **Daily.**

#### Kremlin, Cathedral & Armoury (4hrs)

Not to be missed! Visit the Kremlin grounds to see the Tsar's Bell and Cannon, Kremlin walls and towers. Enter a cathedral where the tsars were baptised, crowned and buried. Visit the State Armoury Museum, housing a unique collection of crown jewels, gems, thrones, carriages, costumes (including the wedding and coronation dresses worn by Catherine the Great), Faberge Eggs and much more. **Daily except Thu.**

#### Tretyakov Art Gallery (3hrs)

The Gallery houses a collection of Russian art that traces the development of Russian culture from the 11th to 19th centuries. The gallery displays Russian icons, canvases by famous Russian portraitists, paintings and graphics

from the early 20th century.

**Daily except Mon.**

#### Pushkin Fine Arts Museum (3.5hrs)

This museum contains the second largest collection of Western European art in Russia, from the Middle Ages to the 20th century – Italian Renaissance, Dutch still-life paintings, Rembrandt, Rubens, the ancient world (Egypt, Syria, Assyria, Greece, Rome) and the largest collection of French Impressionists in Russia. **Daily except Mon.**

#### Novodevichy Convent & Cemetery (2.5hrs)

The convent was founded in 1524. Apart from its religious significance, it served as a place of imprisonment for noblewomen. Adjoining is a necropolis where many cultural and political figures are buried – the writers Chekhov and Gogol, singer Feodor Chaliapin, poet Mayakovsky, composer Shostakovich and political figures such as Krushchev. **Daily except Tue & first Mon of month.**

#### Sergiev Posad (6hrs)

Travel 75km north of Moscow, passing picturesque dacha settlements, to the historic Trinity monastery complex of St Sergius. Founded in the 14th century by St Sergius of Radonezh, Sergiev Posad is the spiritual bastion of Russian Orthodoxy and a popular place of pilgrimage. Boris Godunov is buried here – the only Tsar not buried in the Kremlin or St Petersburg's Peter & Paul Fortress. The monastery is included in UNESCO's World Heritage List. **Daily except Mon.**

### RUSSIA – RAIL SCHEDULES



Rail transportation can only be booked in conjunction with accommodation. Schedules and prices are accurate at the time of printing, but subject to confirmation. 1st class rail is generally 2 berth, with a sleeper included for overnight sectors. 2nd class rail is usually 4 berth for overnight trains and 6 berth or open carriage for day trains. Prices include seat reservation. Russian Railways do not differentiate between sexes when allocating berths. Passport details required. Seat reservations can generally be confirmed 45-35 days prior to travel at which point the tickets will be purchased and hence will become non refundable.
