###### Hermitage Museum

One of the world's greatest museums, exhibiting over 3 million items.

###### Hermitage & Gold Room

See a unique collection of Scythian gold dating from 7th to 2nd centuries BC and priceless treasures of the tsars.

###### Peter & Paul Fortress & St Isaac's Cathedral

Peter and Paul Fortress is the site chosen by Peter the Great in 1703 as the foundation of St Petersburg and the burial place of the Romanovs. St Isaac's Cathedral is the largest church in Russia, accommodating up to 10,000 people. Its vast interiors are adorned with jasper, malachite and marble.

###### Peterhof Palace & Park

Peter the Great's magnificent answer to Versailles, featuring spectacular cascading fountains and golden statues from May to Sep.

###### Peterhof one way by hydrofoil

Travel by hydrofoil to the Gulf of Finland for the most spectacular views of Peterhof and its gardens.

###### Artillery Museum & Siege Museum **NEW**

Founded in 1703 and considered to be one of the best military museums in the world, the Artillery Museum

features valuable collections of weapons, uniforms, artillery equipment, including fascinating exhibits from the Cold War. The Museum of the Defence and Siege of Leningrad is a small but moving museum which commemorates the 900 day Blockade of Leningrad from 8 September 1941 to 17 January 1944 resulting in the death of over 700,000 civilians.

##### Folklore at Nikolaevsky Palace with transfers & refreshments

Spectacular dancing performances and great entertainment in a 19th century palace.

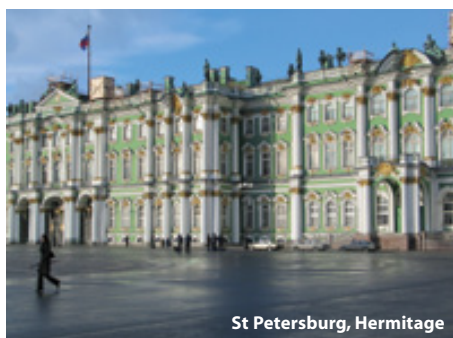

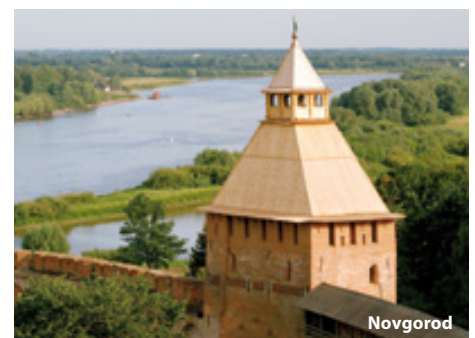

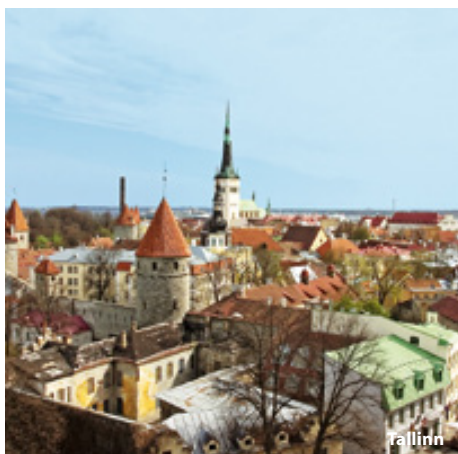

### MOSCOW

#### Private sightseeing

##### Armoury Museum

The oldest museum in Russia, housing a unique collection of the tsars' jewels, icons, costumes, carriages and Faberge eggs.

##### Pushkin Fine Arts Museum

Houses the second largest collection of Western European art in Russia from the Middle Ages to the 20th century.

##### Tretyakov Art Gallery

The Gallery houses a collection of Russian art that traces Russian culture from the 11th to 20th centuries.

##### Novodevichy Convent & Cemetery

This UNESCO-listed convent was founded in 1524. Adjoining is a fascinating cemetery where many famous cultural and political figures are buried, such as Chekhov, Gogol, Shostakovich, Nikita Khrushchev and Boris Yeltsin.

##### Monino Aviation Museum **NEW**

One of the world's largest aviation museums, featuring over 170 aircraft including MiGs and Sukhois. Located about 40kms east of Moscow on an air force base, the tours are conducted by ex pilots.
