CRUISING

CRUISE KL2

8 days / 7 nights

Day 1: Sat: Split to Makarska.

Depart Split at 1.00pm. After lunch sail along the Dalmatian coast to the Makarska Riviera. Afternoon free for relaxation and swimming. Overnight in the port of Makarska. **L**

Day 2: Sun: Makarska to Mljet.

Early morning departure for Mljet. Your first stop is Loviste, on the Peljesac peninsula. Enjoy a refreshing swim. The afternoon is free to explore the salt lakes in the National Park. Overnight in the port of Polaca/Pomena. **BL**

Day 3: Mon: Mljet to Dubrovnik.

After breakfast depart for Dubrovnik – a highlight of the cruise. Arrive Dubrovnik in the late afternoon with time for a stroll around the Old City. The energetic can take a walk along the city walls, almost 2 kilometres. Overnight in the port of Dubrovnik. **BL**

Day 4: Tue: Dubrovnik to Sipan or Trstenik. Morning free to explore Dubrovnik. At midday depart this magnificent town and continue the cruise to the isle of Sipan or the small town of Trstenik on the Peljesac peninsula. Afternoon free for swimming. Overnight in the port of Sipan or Trstenik. **BL**

Day 5: Wed: Sipan to Korcula.

After breakfast depart for Korcula,

the birthplace of Marco Polo. After a relaxing lunch on board you have free time for sightseeing in Korcula with its picturesque squares and medieval atmosphere. Overnight in the port of Korcula. **BL**

Day 6: Thu: Korcula to Hvar.

Morning departure for the Pakleni Islands, for lunch and time for swimming. After lunch depart for Hvar, the longest island in the Adriatic. Time to explore Hvar, with its Renaissance cathedral and oldest community theatre in Europe. Hvar offers plenty of bars and restaurants for your evening's entertainment. Overnight in the port of Hvar. **BL**

Day 7: Fri: Hvar to Bol & Split.

Your first stop this morning is the island of Brač. You will have time for a swim at one of the most popular beaches in Dalmatia, Zlatni Rat near Bol. Bol is a typical fishing town, which has become a popular tourist destination. After lunch you head back to Split with the chance for a swim in one of the many bays of the Island of Brač. Arrive Split late afternoon. Free time to explore this busy port with its Roman heritage. Overnight Split. **BL**

Day 8: Sat: Split. Early breakfast before you farewell the captain, crew and your fellow passengers. Cruise service ends. **B**

CRUISE KL5

8 days / 7 nights

Day 1: Sun: Dubrovnik. You may board your boat any time from 1.00pm. Your first night is spent on board in Dubrovnik. The special charm of this old city is the buildings that have remained from the time of the Dubrovnik Republic. Your afternoon is free to explore the city and the many restaurants, bars and cafes. **D**

Day 2: Mon: Dubrovnik to Korcula. During breakfast, you set sail for Korcula, the birthplace of Marco Polo. Lunch is served on board. Your afternoon is free for independent sightseeing of this island of many legends and monuments. Overnight in the port of Korcula. **BL**

Day 3: Tue: Korcula to Hvar. Early morning departure for the Island of Scedro, where you have lunch and time for a swim. Depart for Hvar, the longest island in the Adriatic, often referred to as the sunshine island. Visit the Renaissance cathedral and the oldest community theatre in Europe, founded in 1612. The city of Hvar is also renowned for its exciting nightlife. Overnight in the port of Hvar. **BL**

Day 4: Wed: Hvar to Trstenik.

Today cruise to the little town of Trstenik on the Peljesac peninsula. Trstenik is a village and harbour in the centre of the southern coast of

the island of Peljesac – population 106. The famous Grgic wine is produced here and you can enjoy a wine-tasting at the local winery during your free time. Overnight in Trstenik harbour. **BL**

Day 5: Thu: Trstenik to Mljet. After breakfast sail towards the island of Mljet. The afternoon is free to explore the salt lakes in the National Park on this peaceful island. In the middle of the lake in the National Park is an old abbey and church. Overnight in the port of Polaca/Pomena. **BL**

Day 6: Fri: Mljet to Sipan. Morning departure for the Elafiti Islands situated in the Adriatic Sea west of Dubrovnik. Swimming and lunch are planned at one of the smaller islands of the Elafiti group. Then continue onto Sipan, the largest island famous for its beautiful scenery and sandy beaches. Overnight Sipan. **BL**

Day 7: Sat: Sipan to Dubrovnik. After breakfast depart for Dubrovnik, the highlight of your cruise. Stop for a short swim, take in the natural beauty along the way and arrive in the late afternoon. Walk through Stradun, which is both a street and square inside the city walls. Overnight in the port of Dubrovnik. **BL**

Day 8: Sun: Dubrovnik. Early breakfast before you say goodbye to the crew and all your new friends. **B**

CRUISE KL 7

8 days / 7 nights

Day 1: Sun: Dubrovnik to Zaton Veliky. Depart Dubrovnik at 1pm and head north past quaint fishing villages for Zaton Veliky. En route stop for a swim. Overnight Zaton. **L**

Day 2: Mon: Zaton Veliki to Perast. After breakfast and customs, leave Croatian waters and sail to Montenegro. Enter Kotor Bay, 25 km deep and surrounded by high mountains. After passport control continue to the islet of Gospa od Skrpjela where the famous Church of Our Lady of the Rock, patroness of seamen and fishermen, is located. Overnight in Perast, a sleepy baroque place near Kotor at the foot of St Elijah Hill, opposite the narrow Verige strait. **BL**

Day 3: Tue: Perast to Kotor. Continue cruising through the Bay of Kotor, famous for its impressive mountains surrounding the triangle-shaped town. The old town of Kotor is a well preserved medieval town, protected by UNESCO. You will have time to explore its narrow twisting streets and ancient buildings on your own or join an optional tour. The tour includes Kotor, stop at Lovcen where you have magnificent views of the entire Kotor Bay and brunch in Njegusi village where you can try the local prosciutto, goat cheese, fresh homemade bread and Vranac red wine. Continue to Cetinje, visit the King Nikola Castle Museum, followed by a photo stop at Sveti Stefan island and the town of Budva. Overnight Kotor. **BL**

Day 4: Wed: Kotor to Šipan (Šucurac). After passport formalities, leave Montenegro and sail to Cavtat with a swim in one of the bays en route. Overnight Šipan (Šucurac) the biggest island of the Elafiti group. **BL**

Day 5: Thu: Šipan to Korcula. After breakfast, depart for Korcula, the birthplace of Marco Polo. Lunch onboard near Lumbarda (part of Korcula) with time to relax and refresh in the clean, crystal blue sea. Your afternoon is free to wander around Korcula, one of the most beautiful historical spots in Dalmatia. **BL**

Day 6: Fri: Korcula to Mljet & Šipan. Today sail for the island of Mljet. Your afternoon is free to explore the salt lakes in the National Park of Mljet. You can visit an old abbey and church in the middle of one of the lakes, or use a small boat or bicycle to roam around the Park. Later leave for Šipan (port of Šipan) where you stay overnight. **BL**

Day 7: Sat: Šipan to Dubrovnik. This morning depart for Dubrovnik. Time for a short swim before enjoying the beautiful scenery along the way towards "the heaven on earth" (according to G.B. Shaw). Arrive in Dubrovnik in the afternoon where you have the rest of the day to walk through the old town. Overnight Dubrovnik (Gruz harbour). **BL**

Day 8: Sun: Dubrovnik. After breakfast, say goodbye to the crew and fellow passengers. Cruise services end. **B**

SHIPS

There are 20 ships used on these routes – 14 category A and 6 category B.



Category A

Aloha, Tuna, Mlini, Maestral, Kapetan Bota, Lopar, Labrador, Dalmatinac, Novi Dan, Tvrdi, Ika, Viktoria, Dalmatinka and Tarin.

These ships were built in early to mid 20th century and refurbished 2000-2005. The length of the boats varies from 21m to 33m and width 5.5m to 7.5m. They carry from 20 to 46 passengers in 10 to 22 cabins. Cabins are compact and have private shower and WC. The ships have a dining area and a small sun deck.

Category B

Mihovil, Madona, Vrgada, Javorak, Omladinac and Penelopa.

Category B ships are generally smaller with an average length of 20m and width of 5m. They were built in the 1960s and refurbished in the late 1990s. They cater for 20 passengers (10 cabins) on average. Cabins are compact, most have a washbasin but no shower or WC – those are shared. Generally there are 3 showers and 3 toilets per boat. Ships have a dining area and a small sun deck.

ROUTE SCHEDULES

Category A ships: KL 1, 2 and 5 depart weekly; KL 3, 4, 6 & 7 have limited departures – see schedule.

Category B ships: available only on KL2 and depart weekly.

SUPPLEMENTS

Extras available (payable on spot)

- English breakfast: Eur 35 pp/week (inc. 2 eggs, bacon, tomato and mushrooms)
- Drinks: Eur 16 pp/week (1 drink – glass of wine, 1 beer or soft drink)
- Captain's dinner: Eur 20 pp
- Full board: Eur 100 pp (minimum 10 passengers).
- Bike rental available in Opatija – Eur 10 per day.
- Parking available in Opatija and Split at approx. Eur 8 per day.

Note: The Captain reserves the right to change the route in bad weather conditions. Towels: As passengers receive 1 towel per week on category A ships (none on category B ships), we suggest that you bring your own towels as well as toiletries.
