

# Along the Adriatic Coast

## CRUISE

### MS ARION **NEW**

Cruise along the dramatic Adriatic coast travelling from Slovenia to Croatia, Montenegro and Bosnia Herzegovina on board the M/S Arion. Constructed in 1965 and completely reconstructed in 2000 this 3-star, 5,888 tonne ship has a crew of 130, and can carry 320 passengers. On board languages are English and French.

### 8 days / 7 nights

**Day 1: Sun: Koper.** Join your cruise in the Slovenian port of Koper. Embarkation after 4.00pm.

**Day 2: Mon: Pula.** Morning arrival in the town of Pula, situated on the Istrian Peninsula of Croatia. Pula has many well-preserved Roman ruins including one of the world's largest amphitheatres. The region is also famous for its wines.

**Day 3: Tue: Zadar.** Zadar was once a dominant city on the Adriatic coast, rivalling Venice. See evidence of Zadar's Roman past and explore its charming narrow streets.

**Day 4: Wed: Split & Korcula.** Morning arrival in Split with its bustling promenade and the UNESCO-listed Roman Diocletian's Palace which merges with the shops and houses. Continue this afternoon to Korcula, famous as the birthplace of Marco Polo. It has been described as a

'mini Dubrovnik' with its picturesque squares and medieval atmosphere.

**Day 5: Thu: Dubrovnik.** The magnificent city of Dubrovnik is a highlight of your cruise. Stroll through the narrow streets of this delightful UNESCO-listed Old Town and walk along the city walls.

**Day 6: Fri: Kotor.** This morning you sail through the amazing Bay of Kotor to Montenegro. The Bay of Kotor and the Old Town are both on UNESCO's World Heritage List. The Bay is the largest European Fjord outside Norway.

**Day 7: Sat: Ploce & Mostar.** The commercial port of Ploce is located in Central Dalmatia. From Ploce you may take an optional tour to the old city of Mostar in Bosnia Herzegovina. You will see the reconstructed 'old bridge' built by the occupying Turks 500 years ago.

**Day 8: Sun: Koper.** Morning arrival Koper where your cruise ends.
