Day 1: Prague. Arrival and transfer to your hotel. Tonight, sample Czech cuisine at a stylish restaurant near Charles Bridge. Overnight Prague. **D**

Day 2: Prague. This morning you will have a private tour of Prague. See Prague's main sights including Wenceslas Square and Rudolfinum before a walk through the Prague Castle. Your tour then continues through the Old Town and finishes on the Old Town Square. Afternoon free. Tonight,

enjoy an opera performance or a concert at one of many Prague's concert halls or theatres. Overnight Prague. **B**

Day 3: Prague & Cesky Krumlov. Today visit Cesky Krumlov, Czech first UNESCO listed town. Situated in Southern Bohemia, close to Austrian border, this 13th century town offers visitors quaint little streets and squares lined with well-preserved houses and museums. The town's main sight is its Castle, the second largest complex in Czech republic. Lunch in a local restaurant before returning to Prague for overnight. **BL**

Day 4: Prague. Tour services finish with a transfer to the airport. **B**

SIGHTSEEING

T1: Grand city tour (3.5hrs).

Drive past the State Opera, National Museum and Wenceslas Square. Stroll through the courtyards of Prague Castle and see St Vitus Cathedral. Continue by coach across the Vltava River to Parizska street, through the old Jewish Quarter, to the Old Town Square. Daily 9.30 & 14.00 hrs 2 Jan-31 Dec.

T3: Old Prague on foot (3hrs).

Visit the historical centre of Prague. From the Powder Tower walk the Royal Route to Old Town Square and along Karlova Street to Charles Bridge. See Prague Castle and finish in the Lesser Town, near St Nicolas Church. Entrance fees not included. Fri, Sun 9.30 hrs 1 Jan-30 Mar & 7 Nov-31 Dec. Wed, Fri, Sun 9.30 hrs 2 Apr-2 Nov.

T4: Vltava River cruise with lunch (2hrs).

A cruise with music and commentary. Panoramic Prague views. Lunch included. Fri, Sat 11.40 hrs 1 Jan-29 Mar. Daily 11.30 1 Apr-2 Nov, Fri, Sat, Sun 11.30 hrs 7 Nov-31 Dec.

T6: Prague by night (4hrs).

Cruise by the Castle District, National Theatre, Vysehrad and Charles Bridge. Dinner with music followed by short coach tour of Prague. Daily 18.40 hrs 1 Jan-31 Mar. Daily 18.30 hrs 1 Apr-31 Dec.

T6a: Folklore party (4hrs).

Experience a night at a typical Czech restaurant. Sample local food at a three-course dinner with aperitif, glass of champagne, coffee and unlimited beer, wine and non-alcoholic beverages. During dinner, enjoy a folklore programme with live music and dancing. Fri, Sat 19.00 hrs 1 Jan-29 Mar & 7 Nov-31 Dec. Thu, Sat 19.00 hrs 3 Apr-1 Nov.

T7: Konopiste Castle (4hrs).

A visit to Konopiste Castle – with historical collections of weapons and furnishings. Sat, Sun 9.00 hrs 5 Apr-2 Nov.

T9: Karlstejn Castle (4.5hrs).

Bohemian Gothic Castle housing the valuable treasures and coronation jewels collected by Bohemian kings. Recommended for keen walkers. In the event Karlstejn Castle is closed, the tour will visit Cesky Sternberk Castle instead. Tue, Sat, Sun 10.15 hrs 1 Jan-30 Mar & 4 Nov-31 Dec. Sat, Sun 13.30 hrs 5 Apr-2 Nov.

T8: Konopiste & Karlstejn Castles (9hrs).

For descriptions, see individual tours. Recommended for keen walkers. Lunch included. Sat, Sun 9.00 hrs 5 Apr-2 Nov.

T10: Kutna Hora (4.5hrs).

Walking tour of the medieval silver mining town including St Barbara's Cathedral and former Royal Mint. UNESCO listed. Tue, Thu, Sat, Sun 12.30 hrs 1 Jan-30 Mar & 4 Nov-31 Dec. Tue, Thu, Sat, Sun 13.30 hrs 1 Apr-2 Nov.

T12: Karlovy Vary (10hrs).

Visit the spa town of Karlovy Vary. Opportunity to buy local glass and china and taste becher liqueur. Visit the Moser glass factory. Lunch included. Wed, Sat 9.00 hrs 1 Jan-29 Mar & 5 Nov-31 Dec. Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat 9.00 hrs 2 Apr-1 Nov.

T13: Cesky Krumlov (10hrs).

Drive through the charming landscape of South Bohemia. Visit the medieval town of Cesky Krumlov. Walking tour of the castle and historical town. Lunch included. Fri 9.00 hrs 1 Jan-28 Mar & 7 Nov-31 Dec. Tue, Fri, Sun 9.00 hrs 1 Apr-31 Oct.

T14: Hluboka & Ceske Budejovice (10hrs).

Enjoy the South Bohemian countryside. See the Neo-Gothic castle at Hluboka, with its collection of furniture, tapestries, porcelain and paintings. After lunch visit the UNESCO listed village of Holasovice and the South Bohemian town of Ceske Budejovice. Lunch included. Wed 9.00 hrs 2 Apr-29 Oct.
